The successful candidate will play a vital role in optimising both player availability and athletic development to positively impact individual and team performances of Peterborough United's First Team squad. The successful candidate will be an experienced practitioner with strong leadership skills and an ability to make data-driven decisions in a fast-paced environment, whilst also having previous experience working in elite sport and understand the level of commitment and proficiency required and has displayed this consistently. The role will be based at the club's training ground and will require attendance at every first team training session as well as match day responsibilities, both home and away, as required.

Main Duties:

- To design and deliver periodised physical development programmes to all 1st team players to enhance performance
- Travel to 1st Team games, to deliver the physical preparation prior to and during matches and in conjunction with the S&C Coach provide an optimal match day provision.
- Develop and deliver structured/ periodised warm-ups to complement pitch-based conditioning.
- In conjunction with other members of staff in the medical and science department, liaise daily with the technical staff (Head coach, assistant head coach etc.) about optimal loading for all 1st Team players
- Measure anthropometry for all club players and take a lead on all nutrition strategies.
- Deliver and design daily pre-activation and injury risk reduction strategies.
- Download, monitor & evaluate physical performance using GPS technology for both training and games, and feedback this information into the coaching staff.
- Keep detailed notes of all physical development sessions completed by players.
- In conjunction with the Senior Physiotherapist, lead an in-house CPD programme in order to review new and emerging literature to inform future practice.
- Produce off-season programmes in conjunction with the other staff to manage the 1st Team player's integration back into the pre-season programme.
