Main Duties

- Lead the development and performance analysis department including all analysis support staff and interns
- Alongside the First Team Coaching staff lead on pre and post-match debriefing at a team, unit and individual level
- Support first team coaching staff with individual and unit analysis to support player development.
- Provide analysis and technical support for all First Team match days
- Provide on pitch support to first team coaches within training sessions through live coding and drone filming.
- Manage daily performance analysis team meetings.
- Drive consistency and alignment across all performance analysis departments within the club including the Academy
- Provide analysis of opposition teams and players to support the first team performances and results
- Assist first team coaching staff on recruitment analysis of potential players for the Club
